The LEADER grant helped the business increase capacity for processing the raw material (AKA apples) and improving the infrastructure alongside a new kegging line. The grant covered the construction of a new press house and reception pit, as well as new equipment to ensure that this successful local business continues to thrive and provide employment in this stunning corner of Dorset.
